

WOLVES SHOOTOUT

- **Winners of each age bracket in the Wolves Shooting Contest win a Minnesota Timberwolves prize pack!**
- **You also have the chance to be entered in a drawing to win a pair of season tickets for the Timberwolves 2008-2009 season.**

Contest Information:

1. Anyone can take part in the shooting contest. The contest will be divided up into 3 age categories:
 1. Ages 10 and under
 2. Ages 11 to 17
 3. Ages 18 and above
2. Players can be any age to participate.
3. Each player has one minute to score as many baskets as possible from any of the six shooting spots identified on the court.
4. Each shooting spot value is indicated on each shooting spot. Point values range from 2 to 8 points.
5. Basketballs to be used are provided.
6. The winner of each age bracket with the highest score wins Timberwolves prize pack. If there is a tie, a winner will be drawn randomly between the players with the tie.

Contest Rules:

1. The player may begin at any spot on the court. The referee indicates when play begins. Each player gets 60 seconds to make as many shots as possible.
2. The player can move around the court to any spot and take a shot. Players can't shoot consecutively from same spot and all invalid shots will not be counted.
3. Each player gets **two lay-ups worth 2 points** during each competition. All other shooting spots may be used for unlimited shots. (Rule doesn't apply to 10 and under bracket)
4. When shooting, the player must begin with a portion of one foot touching the shooting spot. Jump shots are allowed.
5. Referees reserve the right to determine whether shots count based on the rules.
